12th Oct'25 Day 01– Arrival in Delhi

13th Oct'25 Day 02- Delhi

Breakfast

Breakfasts at your hotel. Breakfast timing 7.30 AM onwards.

At 0900 hrs, pick up from your hotel to discover the modern city of New Delhi, which includes Gurudwara Bangla Sahib, the largest Sikh temple of Delhi, with a gold tomb, still in active worship; Photo stop at India Gate, the war memorial arch built in honor of the soldiers who died in the second world war; drive past President's House, Parliament House and other Government Secretariat Buildings which are the most imposing features of Lutyen's Delhi. Also, visit Humayun's Tomb, a fine example Indo-Islamic architecture and the world's tallest minaret. Afterwards enjoy the day discovering Delhi, pacing through the city, which is as historic as modern! Enjoy an afternoon sightseeing tour of Old Delhi, which includes drive pass of Red Fort, the place that marked the announcement of India's freedom from the British Raja visit to Jama Masjid, the largest mosque in India; a rickshaw ride in Chandni Chowk mark, 'silver street', one of the largest trading centers of India.

Stay overnight at hotel.



13th Oct'25 Day 03 – Delhi – Varanasi (Flight)

Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast at your hotel, check out and transfer straight to Delhi airport from where you board your onward flight to Varanasi.

Arrive in Varanasi, followed by assisted transfer to your hotel.

Later in the afternoon, enjoy the tour of Old city to explore this oldest spiritual living city in the world. Once abode of Lord Shiva and Godess Parvati, the origins of Varanasi are yet unknown. The city is a centre of learning and civilization for over 3000 years.. The city is also renowned for its rich tapestry of music, arts, crafts and education.

Evening enjoy the Aarti ceremony on the ghats of river Ganges from the boat. Stay overnight at your hotel.

14th Oct'25 Day 04 – Varanasi

Breakfast & Dinner

Start your day with a sunrise boat ride on river Ganges and witness the people with Hindu faith, ritually bathing in the sacred river, for it is believed as per Hindu mythology that bathing in the holy river of Ganga causes the remission of sins and facilitates the attainment of nirvana. Ghats of Varanasi are a natural supplement to the concept of divinity and is known as the city that liberates soul from human body to ultimate

Return to hotel for breakfast followed by an excursion to Sarnath where Lord Buddha preached his first sermon at the deer park after his enlightenment. Sarnath is one of the four holy Buddhist sites sanctioned by the Buddha himself for pilgrimage, one of the richest in Buddhist antiquities ranging in date from the times of Ashoka down to the 12th century A.D Ashoka, who built here the Dharmarajika Stupa and near it erected a pillar surmounted by the magnificent capital of four adorned Lions, which today forms the national emblem of India.

Stay overnight at your hotel.



15th Oct'25 Day 05 – Varanasi – Delhi (Flight) - Agra

Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast check out from the hotel. Later in time transfer to Varanasi airport for your flight to Delhi. Arrive at Delhi airport and drive towards Agra.

The capital of the Mughal Empire in the 16th and 17th centuries, Agra is home to three UNESCO world heritage sites: the Taj Mahal, Agra Fort and the ancient city of Fatehpur Sikri; all of which are legacies from Mughal times.

Upon arrival check into your hotel.

Located just 600 metres from the Taj Mahal, the world's most exquisite testimony to undying love, it is easy to rekindle romance at The Oberoi Amarvilas. It is inspired by Mughal palace designs; with fountains, terraced lawns, reflection pools and pavilions, and offers unrestricted views of Taj Mahal from all rooms and suites, complemented by our warm, personalized hospitality.

16th Oct'25 Day 06 – Agra

Breakfast

Today at Sunrise, visit one of the Seven Wonders of the World, the ethereal Taj Mahal which is also listed among UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Built by Shah Jahan for his beloved wife, the iconic white structure is an epitome of eternal love. After the visit return to your hotel for breakfast.

Next, proceed to a visit to the red-sandstone fortress of Agra, Agra Fort - a visit to the fort in 'Agra' is must since so many of the events which lead to the construction of the Taj took place here. This fascinating structure has many interesting sights to keep you busy. Lastly you shall visit Itmadaullah tomb which is often described as Jewellery box - also known as baby Taj. Empress Noor Jehan commissioned it in memory of her father. The tomb is of particular interest since many of its design elephants overshadow the Taj. Later part of the day you can spend exploring the local markets, marble in lay workshops at the Emporiums and much more. Free evening followed by overnight Stay at hotel.



17th Oct'25 Day 07 – Agra – Fatehpur Sikri - Bharatpur (Local train) – Ranthambhore

Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast check out and we will be on our way towards Ranthambhore.

Enroute visit Fatehpur Sikri.

Fatehpur Sikri - The deserted red sandstone city built by the great Mughal Emperor Akbar as his capital and palace in the late 16th century. It was abandoned soon after it was built when the local wells went dry and it remains today in much the same condition that it was over 300 years ago. It is complete with palaces and mosques and used to be a town larger than London when it was originally constructed. Now it is an extraordinary place to wander around with its buildings in near perfect condition. At the foot of the ridge, an artificial lake has been created which forms one side of the city. The three other sides are protected by awesome walls with 9 gates. In 1584, only 14 years after moving here, Akbar abandoned this short-lived capital because of a shortage of water. Today the perfectly preserved public halls and private residences speak of a telling unity; it is an epic poem in red sandstone.

After the visit drive to Bharatpur train station wherein we await our short train journey to Sawai Madhopur (Ranthambhore). Indian railways are one of the biggest in the world and you will just get a short glimpse of the rural lifeline of India.

Arrive in Ranthambhore (Sawai Madhopur Train Station) and transfer to your hotel followed by check in.

Ranthambhore National Park was declared a wildlife sanctuary in 1957 and in 1974 it gained the protection of the Government of India's Project Tiger conservation programme. Since then, the numbers of resident tigers have been increasing thanks to dedicated conservation efforts in the area. Ranthambore National Park is one of the biggest and most renowned national parks in Northern India.

Stay overnight.



18th Oct'25 Day 08 - Ranthambhore

(All Meals)

Today your day is filled with Morning and Afternoon Jeep Safaris. The population of Bengal Tigers in Ranthambhore Tiger Reserve is currently estimated to be around eighty. The number of sightings has doubled in the last three years.

Am Park Safari (October): 0630AM – 1000AM PM Park Safari (October): 1430PM – 1800PM

In between the safaris take some time oute to hike up to Ranthambhore Fort - a vast UNESCO World Heritage Site that overlooks the park and dates back one thousand years. Rest of the day is free to enjoy activities at your resort. Stay overnight.

19th Oct'25 Day 09 – Ranthambhore – Abhaneri – Jaipur

Breakfast & Diwali Dinner

After breakfast check out. We will drive towards Jaipur however take a D tour to visit Abhaneri Stepwells.

Chand Baori (stepwell) in the Abhaneri village is one of the oldest and most popular attractions in Rajasthan. It was built by King Chanda of the Nikumbha Dynasty in 9th century AD. One of the largest stepwells in the world, Chand Baori was built to conserve water and provide a respite from the intense heat. It was a community gathering place for locals as well as royals. Chand Baori is an architectural wonder with 3,500 perfectly symmetrical, narrow steps. It is this exquisite geometry that draws local and international visitors to it every year. But Chand Baori is not easy to find, making it one of India's hidden wonders. The play of light and shadow on the steps is what makes the structure so captivating. The baori narrows as one gets closer to the bottom. A double flight of steps on three sides takes one to the surface of the water below. The fourth side is a three-storeyed pavilion with intricately carved jharokhas (windows), galleries and balconies meant for the royal family to sit in. Adjoining the Chand Baori is the Harshat Mata Temple. This 9th-10th century temple is dedicated to Harshat Mata, who is considered to be the goddess of joy and happiness for the whole village.



Arrive in Jaipur. The famous walled capital city of Rajasthan. Jaipur has been fondly known as the "Pink City" since it was painted pink in 1876 as a sign of the people's hospitality towards the visiting Queen Victoria of England and the Prince of Wales.

Upon arrival check into Oberoi Rajvilas, Jaipur.

Experience a sincerely warm welcome when you stay with at The Oberoi Rajvilas. Spread over 1,29,499 square metres of beautifully landscaped gardens, with traditional architecture, flaming mashaal torches and reflection pools.

Diwali Highlight (Diwali days may fall on either 20th or 21st as per Hindu calendar) – Each guest will be presented with an Indian traditional wear to dress up and be collected from hotel lobby for their Diwali dinner. Leave from your hotel to Visit the local Indian family House. The local family will offer you traditional welcome. Afterwards they lead you to their house where they perform Pooja and tell you the meaning of every ritual they perform followed by Parsahadam and then fire crackers outside. This is followed by dinner at the hotel.

Overnight stay in the hotel.

20th Oct'25 Day 10 – Jaipur

Breakfast

After an energizing breakfast, begin the sightseeing excursion. First, pay a visit to the yellow-sandstone Amber Fort, one of the Hill Forts of Rajasthan listed among UNESCO World Heritage sites in India. The fortress has many specimens of interesting building. From here we proceed to visit Jaipur City – Places to visit here are **City Palace**, known for its mix of Rajasthani and Mughal architecture. We will also visit an astronomical observatory i.e. **Jantar Mantar** from several centuries ago, equipped with instruments of surprising size and high precision. From here we drive pass **Hawa Mahal** (**Palace of Winds**) also known as the palace of winds , a facade full of windows.

After the visit we proceed to visit Local market for shopping activities.

From here transfer to your hotel. Overnight stay in the hotel.



21st Oct'25 Day 11 – Jaipur - Udaipur (Flight)

Breakfast & Dinner

<u> Optional – Hot Air Balloon safari @ USD 300.00 Per Person</u>

If you feel adventurous you can enjoy a Hot Air Balloon Safari from Amber Fort – subject to weather condition. Fly above Hawa Mahal, Amber Fort to get a 360 degree view of the Pink City, or stare out at the far-reaching sand dunes. From above, the golden sands shine with splendour and appear majestic. Feel like a mediaeval monarch while discovering the historical and breathtaking monuments of the Aravalli Range.

After breakfast, check out at the hotel. Later in time transfer to airport for your flight to Udaipur.

Upon arrival transfer to your hotel, The Oberoi Udaivilas and check into your hotel.

Cruise past its stunning island palaces, including the ethereal Jag Mandir, Rows of charming havelis, both well-restored and crumbling, line the lakefront, and behind this medieval façade stretches a maze of bustling and colorful shops and stalls.

23rd Oct'25 Day 13 – Arrival in Mumbai

Board your flight from Udaipur to Mumbai. Upon arrival transfer to your hotel followed by check in.

On reaching Mumbai, meet your tour executive. Get assisted transferred to your hotel room. Complete check-in formalities and relax for some time.

Evening enjoy Heritage walking tour of Mumbai. We start from Gateway of India and walk through the lanes discovering various historic and architectural gems like Regal Cinema – Art Deco Building, Prince of Wales museum from outside, Elphinstone College, a Gothic-Victorian-style university campus, 19th-century David Sassoon Library - mid-19th-century neo-classical facade, University of Bombay, Next to the University is the High Court of Mumbai built in 1878, Flora Fountain built in 1864 depicting the Roman goddess Flora, Victoria Terminus Railway Station designed by Frederick William Stevens, a consulting architect in 1887-1888.

After the walk return to your hotel followed by overnight stay at hotel.

24th Oct'25 Day 14 – Day in Mumbai

Breakfast

Breakfast at the hotel and afterwards proceed for sightseeing tour in & around Mumbai.

DABBA WALA TOURS The guests will be pick up at around 1000 hrs and will be transferred to Churchgate railway station for a short train ride. Here they will see Dabbawala's disembarking the tiffins in the wooden cart from the train. Guests arrive at Mahalaxmi Railway Station which is situated next to Municipal Dhobi Ghats at Mahalakshmi, on the suburb of



Mumbai. Most of the Dabba walas get down at Mahalaxmi Station as all the Corporate offices are in this vicinity. Here the Dabbawalas sort out the Tiffin Boxes based on the markings which is done area wise. A brief introduction here with the dabbawalas and their exact arrangements how the Tiffin's are coded and distributed at the right place at the right time. The Tiffins are loaded on the Wooden Crate which carries 150 Tiffins and driven.

DHOBI GHAT Visit - Open Air Laundry locally known as **DHOBI GHAT**. A unique feature of Mumbai, the dhobi is a traditional laundryman, who will collect household dirty linen, wash it, iron them and deliver to their doorstep for a nominal charge. The "laundries" are called "ghats" where almost two hundred dhobis and their families work together in what has always been a hereditary occupation. After the visit return to your hotel.

From here proceed with your guide towards The Gateway of India where you will board the local ferry for an excursion to Elephant Island – to explore the rock art of the Elephanta Caves. You reach here by public ferry or by private boat transfer. On your arrival at the island, you will proceed to the Elephanta Caves, which contain a collection of rock art linked to the sect of Shiva. At Elephanta, Indian art found one of its most perfect expressions, particularly in the huge and high relics of the main cave.

Overnight stay at hotel.

25th Oct'25 Day 03 – Mumbai Departure

After breakfast, morning free at hotel.

Later in time, transfer to Mumbai airport to bard your flight for onward journey.
