DAY 2: OCTOBER 14, 2024

KIGALI GENOCIDE MEMORIAL

During a Kigali City Tour learn about Rwanda's past and its exciting future. A moving visit to the Kigali Genocide Memorial offers a lesson in forgiveness and hope. Almost 250,000 victims of the genocide against the Tutsi tribe are buried within the grounds of the Kigali Genocide Memorial. This guided tour serves not only to educate visitors about the horrors of the genocide by means of three permanent exhibitions, but it is also a meaningful tribute to those who perished.

After lunch, travel through the beautiful terraced hillsides, gradually ascending into the Virunga Mountains. Settle into your lodge and let the sights and sounds of the rainforest envelop you. (BLD)




DAY 3: OCTOBER 15, 2024

VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK

Rise early to start tracking through the steep and often muddy forest. While you may be lucky and catch up with the gorillas by mid-morning, sometimes tracking them down can take a full day, especially when it is wet. Quietly observe them as they feed on the lush foliage and tend to each other with uncannily human-like mannerisms. Return to the lodge in time for a late lunch and schedule your complimentary massage. Pre-purchase of a gorilla permit is required. (BLD)

DAY 4: OCTOBER 16, 2024

VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK

Choose from a variety of optional excursions or perhaps go on a second trek or track the lively golden monkeys. Pre-purchase of a gorilla permit / golden monkey permit is required. Trek in the footsteps of the late activist Dian Fossey on a full-day hike to visit her grave site and the remains of her Karisoke Research Center. Visit Lake Kivu, take a guided walk to Lake Bulera or visit the Imbabazi Orphanage and have tea or lunch with the staff and volunteers. (BLD)

Most of all, you will soak up the warmth of Kigali's people and culture. Your time here is sure to promise memories to last a lifetime.




Virunga Lodge
